(The only medically proven causes of motion sickness are listed below.)

Motion sickness occurs when the inner ear (semicircular canals and otolith organs), which controls balance and senses the turbulence of the vehicle, senses a mismatch with the visual information received by the eyes, confusing the brain and disrupting the autonomic nervous system. Sudden acceleration or turbulence can cause this mismatch, resulting in cold sweats, dizziness, and nausea. Effective prevention measures include getting enough sleep the night before, taking motion sickness medication, and sitting in a forward-facing seat.
